Skill Set description

This skill set develops the core knowledge and practical skills required to provide person centered support to older people in various settings. This will complement your existing CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support.

Total units of competency: 3

CHCAGE001 Facilitate the empowerment of older people

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to respond to the goals and aspirations of older people and provide support services in a manner that focuses on improving health outcomes and quality of life, using a person-centered approach.

CHCAGE005 Provide support to people living with dementia

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide person-centered care and support to people living with dementia to work in a residential or community context, including family homes.

CHCCCS011 Meet personal support needs

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to determine and respond to an individual's physical personal support needs and to support activities of daily living.

Students must meet eligibility criteria and pay a co-contribution fee to receive this funding.

- Must already hold a CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support
- Have not completed a Certificate IV or higher-level qualification.
