- Hold a Certificate III in Individual Support (or superseded qualification) and be an existing worker in the Aged Care industry sector

Qualification

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged care services, either in residential or home and community-based environments. Worker will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery. Worker may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters

Pathways to further study

This course covers units from the national training package, so participants may receive recognition towards other qualifications including Certificate IV in Disability, Certificate IV in Leisure and Health, Certificate IV in Mental Health or Diploma of Nursing.
