- Unique Student Identifier (USI)
- All required vaccinations (influenza and COVID-19)

Course is on offer at our Maroochydore Campus

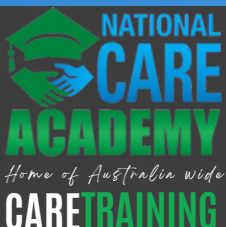
Students are required to complete at least 120 hours of vocational placement as part of course requirements.
